Toward the end of each section, we would have a class discussion which was a great opportunity to go over concepts that some students may have needed clarification on, simply forgot, missed a class, or have specific questions, and then we would have a paper/exam due in a couple of days following the class discussion. We would talk about topics such as AI, animals, lies, cheating, etc. Real-life situations where we would apply different philosophical approaches and ethical lenses to analyze topics such as such.
